Underground Railroad – 10 sessions – Sept. 14, Oct. 12, Nov. 9, Dec. 14, 2013, Jan. 11, Feb. 8, March 8, April 12, May 10, June 14, 2014 – Instructor: Dottie Raab

**Description:** This class includes what you should know and practice before attempting heirloom machine quilting with trapunto and feathers. **You should be familiar with your machine and its settings** for needle down, free-motion quilting, dropped feed dogs and tension adjustment. You will learn ergonomic techniques for working with your machine for long periods of time, marking, basting, navigating the quilt top, grid quilting, echo quilting, continuous lines, stippling to enhance the top design and numerous background quilting design choices. 
Storm at Sea – November 2, 2013; 10am – 4pm – Instructor: Kim Jallette

**Description:** Using the "Square in a Square" ruler, make the traditional Storm at Sea pattern more easily than ever imagined, without cutting any individual triangles or using a paper-piecing technique. Everyone loves this design, with its optical illusions of curved piecing (no, there isn't any!!)

Suitable for a confident beginner; you should be able to accurately rotary cut strips and sew a consistent ¼" seam allowance. No experience with the "Square in a Square" ruler is required.

Pre-class preparation includes cutting your strips at home so that you can begin sewing almost immediately in class.
