

Supply List for Cathedral Window

*Background Fabric - Cut 8" Squares (must have for first class)

Fabric For Inserted Squares - Cut 2 1/2" Squares (must have for second class)

Dritz Wooden Quilting Point Turner & Creaser

Clover Hera Marker #490NV

Thread to match background fabric - Aurifil or Superior

Needle Threader (if you need one)

Hand Sewing Needles

Straight Pins

Scissors for snipping threads

Wand Iron or other small Iron if you have one

Small Cutting Mat (12" x 18", or whatever size you have)

Omnigrid Ruler, 1" x 12"

When determining how much fabric you need for the background, you must first decide what size Cathedral Window you wish to make (pillow, wall hanging, table cover, small or large quilt, etc.).

An 8" square of background fabric yields a 3 3/4" finished square.

You will need almost as many fabric square inserts as you have blocks.

*Cut all squares on the straight grain of fabric. Use the same grid for all cuts when cutting your background squares - all grids are not created equal. Accuracy in cutting will make constructing your cathedral window much easier.
