Description and Supply List for Learn A Log Cabin-Beginner Series

This is a Log Cabin class with the beginner in mind. In this two class beginner series, the student will learn how to piece the traditional Log Cabin block and how to arrange nine blocks into a 35"X35" baby quilt or wall hanging. The guidebook for this log cabin adventure is *Make a Quilt In a Day-Log Cabin Pattern by Eleanor Burns*

The class will include discussion on light and dark fabrics as seen in the log cabin design as well as instruction on rotary cutting if needed.

Time will be given during class time to purchase fabric if you don't have fabrics in mind.

Supply List: Fabric

In the sample there is between 3 and 4 different prints of light and dark fabric used. A total of one yard light fabric and one yard of dark fabric is needed.

For Center Squares and border: ½ yard

Border fabric: ½ yd Binding fabric: ½ yd Backing fabric: 1 ¼' yd

Batting: 40" X 40" square

Other Supplies:

Book by Eleanor Burns

Rotary cutter and quilter's ruler

100% neutral color thread for piecing

Pins

Sewing machine in good working order

Piecing foot if you have one for your machine

Any other sewing supplies that you may like to use

BEFORE CLASS (if you have your fabric and would like to cut before class)

If you are comfortable with rotary cutting, cut $3 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ wide strips across the width of the fabric from each of the light and dark fabrics. Or you can get assistance in class.

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
